that are growing across all spheres of young people's lives as well as the challenges to active citizenship that children growing up in unjust sociopolitical contexts face. The volume is interdisciplinary and draws on the sociology of childhood, children's literature studies, youth culture studies, media technology and cultural studies, and Anthropocene, ecofeminist, and disability studies. Agency occurs in and around literature and storytelling, and this collection establishes how it is always influenced by identity as well as geopolitics, how it is both subjective and collective, how it is cultural and embodied, and how, like citizenship, it is not a static status but rather an ongoing negotiation. In this collection, contributors invite readers to consider agency as a system of relations between children themselves, between children and adults, children and institutions, and children and nation states, as well as between children and the nonhuman. This book reviews the interconnectedness between these relationships and attempts to untangle some of the complications that emerge.

Jackie Cuevas, Cristina Herrera, Alexander Lalama, Angel Daniel Matos, Regina Marie Mills, Joseph Isaac Miranda, Jesus Montaño, Domino Renee Perez, Regan Postma, Montaño, Cristina Rhodes, and Sonia Alejandra Rodriguez. *Atravesados: Essays on Queer Latinx Young Adult Literature* shows how Latinx queer YA writers discard the same old story and offer critical representations of queerness that broaden YA writing and insist on the presence of queer teens of color. *Atravesados* draws on foundational Chicana queer theorist Gloria Anzaldúa's notion of *atravesados* to speak to the spectrum of queer youth Latinidades as they materialize in YA literature. Los *atravesados*, according to Anzaldúa, are the squint-eyed, the perverse, the queer, the troublesome, the mongrel, the mulatto, the half-breed, the half-dead, in short, those who cross over, pass over, or through the confines of the normal. Los *atravesados* reside in the borderlands, space of *ni de aquí, ni de allá*, neither here nor there, present yet liminal, their queerness the very source of both frustration and empowerment, a paradox of joy and tragedy. Although written in 1987, Anzaldúa's theory speaks to the realities of queer Latinx teens that fill the pages of YA literature well into the twenty-first century. Characters such as Juliet from Gabby Rivera's *Juliet Takes a Breath*, Aaron from Adam Silvera's *More Happy Than Not*, or the titular Chulito from Charles Rice Gonzales's novel encompass the highs, lows, and everything in betweenness of queer Latinx teen lived experiences. This collection tells their stories. Contributors speak to the spectrum of queer youth Latinidades as they materialize in YA literature, paying close attention to representation and the ways youth are portrayed, whether accurate or stereotypical. Close attention is paid to books that succeed in broadening the field of YA, highlighting authors that draw from their own lived experiences and situate strong, fully developed characters. Taken together, these essays move beyond the page, explaining to readers why representation and authenticity matter in YA literature, as well as the far-reaching effects they can have for real-world queer Latinx teens.

The Digital Future of English Simone Murray, 2025-07-18. More than any other academic discipline, literary studies is the creation of print culture. How then can it thrive in the digital era? Early 1990s predictions of the book's imminent demise presented a simplistic either/or choice between the legacy of moribund print and triumphalist digital technology. Yet we have grown to experience the two media as complexly interdependent and even complementary. Clearly, digital does not kill print. But literary studies in the digital era cannot simply resume business as usual. It is urgently necessary to reconsider the discipline's founding assumptions in light of digital technology. The digital era prompts a rethinking of literary studies' object of study as well as its methods, theories, audiences and pedagogical practices.
