Are they ready to invite one or more of their children to become their partners in making their medical decisions? 4. How can parents and children work together in determining when it's no longer safe or wise for the parents to drive? 5. What end-of-life decisions should parents be prepared to make? What is the best way to have those discussions? *Necessary Conversations* is filled with stories and examples from many families, most with different life circumstances but all facing these same issues. The chapters end with "Getting Started," a list of suggestions for action as well as "Questions for focusing on practical outcomes" to the discussions.
