Ned Kelly as Memory Dispositif Laura Basu, 2012-12-06 Nineteenth century outlaw Ned Kelly is perhaps Australia's most famous historical figure Ever since he went on the run in 1878 his story has been repeated time and again in every conceivable medium Although the value of his memory has been hotly contested and arguably because of this he remains perhaps the main national icon of Australia Kelly's flamboyant crimes turned him into a popular hero for many Australians during his lifetime and far beyond a symbol of freedom anti authoritarianism anti
