Problems faced by Virginians during Reconstruction

- Millions of freed African Americans needed
 - (1) housing (2) education (3) clothing (4) food (5) jobs
- Virginia's economy was in ruins:
 - Money had no value.
 - Banks were closed.
 - Railroads, bridges, plantations, and crops were destroyed.

Measures taken to resolve problems

- The <u>Freedmen's Bureau</u> was a government agency that provided (1) food, (2) schools, and (3) medical care for freed African Americans and others in Virginia.
- Sharecropping was a system common in Virginia after the war in which freedmen and poor white farmers rented land from a landowner by promising to pay the owner with a share of the crop.

<u>Standard VS.8b:</u> SWBAT demonstrate knowledge of the reconstruction of Virginia following the Civil War by identifying the effects of segregation and "Jim Crow" on life in Virginia for whites, African Americans, and American Indians.
