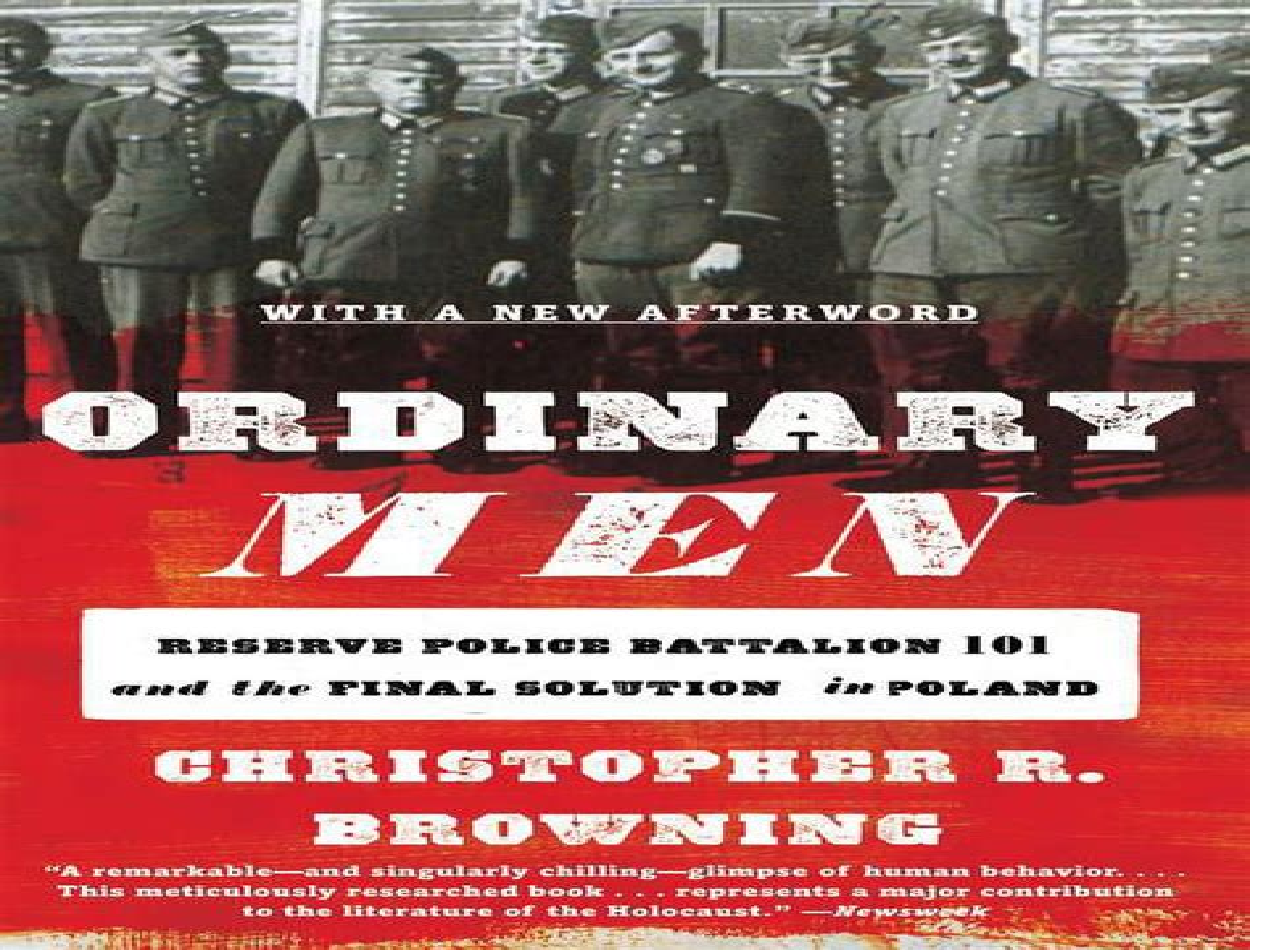

The Hidden Victims Cormac Ó Gráda, 2024-09-03 For example while the human toll of the Jewish Holocaust is generally agreed to have been about 6 million the tolls of two other war genocides those of the Armenian community in Turkey during World War I and of the European Roma community during World War II cannot be determined with any precision Scholarly estimates of these range from 0.6 to 1.2 million and from at least 130 000 to between 250 000 and 500 000 During World War II Chinese civilians faced both a civil war and Japanese occupation and no estimate of the resulting civilian deaths which range from an implausibly low 2.5 million to 20 million is reliable The book shows that the single biggest cause of civilian deaths during the two wars were famines some of which are familiar and well documented while others have attracted research only recently and a few await systematic analysis

Marching into Darkness Waitman Wade Beorn, 2014-01-06 On October 10 1941 the Jewish population of the Belarusian village of Krucha was rounded up and shot This atrocity was not the routine work of the SS but was committed by a regular German army unit acting on its own initiative Marching into Darkness is a bone chilling exposé of the ordinary footsoldiers who participated in the Final Solution on a daily basis Although scholars have exploded the myth that the Wehrmacht played no significant part in the Holocaust a concrete picture of its involvement has been lacking Marching into Darkness reveals in detail how the army willingly fulfilled its role as an agent of murder on a massive scale Waitman Wade Beorn unearths forced labor sexual violence and grave robbing though a few soldiers refused to participate and even helped Jews Improvised extermination progressively became methodical with some army units going so far as to organize Jew hunts The Wehrmacht also used the pretense of Jewish anti partisan warfare as a subterfuge by reporting murdered Jews as partisans Through military and legal records survivor testimonies and eyewitness interviews Beorn paints a searing portrait of an army's descent into ever more intimate participation in genocide

The Holocaust and Masculinities Björn Krondorfer, Ovidiu Creangă, 2020-04-01 Critically assesses the experiences of men in the Holocaust In recent decades scholarship has turned to the role of gender in the Holocaust but rarely has it critically investigated the experiences of men as gendered beings Beyond the clear observation that most perpetrators of murder were male men were also victims survivors bystanders beneficiaries accomplices and enablers they negotiated roles as fathers spouses community leaders prisoners soldiers professionals authority figures resisters chroniclers or ideologues This volume examines men's experiences during the Holocaust Chapters first focus on the years of genocide Jewish victims of National Socialism Nazi soldiers Catholic priests enlisted in the Wehrmacht Jewish doctors in the ghettos men from the Sonderkommando in Auschwitz and Muslim men in the camps The book then moves to the postwar context German Protestant theologians Jewish refugees non Jewish Austrian men and Jewish masculinities in the United States The contributors articulate the male experience in the Holocaust as something obvious the everywhere of masculinities and yet invisible the nowhere of masculinities lending a new perspective on one of modernity's most infamous chapters This is a carefully constructed and field defining work that will influence a generation of new scholars and be cited and discussed for years to come It builds on

Deadly Documents Mark Ward, 2016-12-05 Scholars teachers and practitioners of organizational professional and technical communication and rhetoric are target audiences for a new book that reaches across those disciplines to explore the dynamics of the Holocaust More than a history the book uses the extreme case of the Final Solution to illumine the communicative constitution of organizations and to break new ground on destructive organizational communication and ethics *Deadly Documents* Technical Communication Organizational Discourse and the Holocaust Lessons from the Rhetorical Work of Everyday Texts starts with a microcosmic look at a single Nazi bureau Through close rhetorical visual and discursive analyses of organizational and technical documents produced by the SS Security Police Technical Matters Group the bureau that managed the Nazi mobile gas van program author Mark Ward shows how everyday texts functioned as boundary objects on which competing organizational interests could project their own interpretations and temporarily negotiate consensus for their parts in the Final Solution The initial chapters of *Deadly Documents* provide a historical ethnography of the SS technical bureau by closely describing the institutional and organizational cultures in which it operated and relating organizational stories told in postwar testimony by the desk murderers themselves Then through examination of the primary material of their documents Ward demonstrates how this Social Darwinist world of competing Nazi bureaucrats deployed rhetorical and linguistic resources to construct a social reality that normalized genocide Ward goes beyond the usual Weberian bureaucratic paradigm and applies to the problem of the Holocaust both the interpretive view that sees organizations as socially constructed through communication and the postmodern view that denies the notion of a preexisting social object called an organization and instead situates it within larger discourses The concluding chapters trace how contemporary scholars of professional communication have wrestled with the Nazi case and developed a consensus explanation that the desk murderers were amoral technocrats Though the explanation is dismissed by most historians it nevertheless offers Ward argues a comforting distance between us and them Yet as Ward writes First we will learn more about the dynamic role of everyday texts in organizational processes Second as we see these processes perhaps inherent to all organized communities including our own at work even in the extreme case of the SS Technical Matters Group the comforting distance that we now maintain between them and us is necessarily diminished And third our newfound discomfort may open productive spaces to revisit conventional wisdoms about the ethics of technical and organizational communication
