Organised Sexual Abuse Michael Salter, 2013 This book examines the sexual abuse of children by groups or networks It reviews the debates and controversy surrounding organised abuse and examines case studies of 21 adults in Australia who experienced organised sexual abuse in childhood Themes discussed include the relationship between sexual abuse and organised abuse debates on allegations and recovered memories police responses the contexts in which sexually abusive groups develop and operate the role of religion and ritual in subcultures of organised sexual abuse and the experience of adult and child victims in the criminal justice system and health system **Organised Abuse** Peter C. Adult Accounts of Organised Child Sexual Abuse in Australia Michael Salter (Ph. D.),2010 Organised abuse is an uncommon form of child abuse however it has been one of the most controversial issues in debates over child abuse memory and the law This thesis documents and analyses accounts of organised abuse from twenty one adult survivors in order to develop a deeper understanding of the range of circumstances and contexts in which organised abuse arises and the forms of abuse to which children are subjected in organised contexts I draw from a range of feminist and critical masculinity theorists to consider how organised abuse contributes to and crafts relations between men women and children and how such profoundly abusive relations emerge out of everyday institutions such as the family and school Within the sexual subcultures of abusive groups the structured powerlessness of children signifies them as potential objects of exchange between men who seek to affirm masculine domination and accrue status and prestige through shared performances of control transgression and sexual violence Whilst the violence of these performances can reach extraordinary heights the control mechanisms through which children are subjugated to organised abuse rest upon the socially legitimised power of their abusers who are usually parents

Trauma-Organized Systems Arnon Bentovim, 2018-03-26 This book is about the experience of individuals who have been abused or who have abused others but it also traces the way an abusive experience can organize a family or professional system so that changes are difficult to achieve The author has been in the forefront of the child abuse field for many years and he discusses in this volume the way his thinking has changed to incorporate the ideas from the feminist movement and the constructionist family therapists He looks at the way victimizing actions and the traumatic effects of abuse combine to create a trauma organized system which includes the individual the family the professional helpers the community and the cultural values The author describes the characteristics of these systems and a diagnostic procedure to help the workers plan the treatment

Missing and Sexually Exploited Children in the EU Gert Vermeulen,H. de Pauw,2004 The first part of the project resulted in a book entitled Missing and sexually exploited children in the EU Epidemiological data The book stresses the importance of EU wide multidisciplinary and integrated efforts between competent authorities and civil society organisations in collecting epidemiological data as a basis for improved knowledge based policy making in the area of missing and sexually exploited minors It comprises country reports of all 15 EU Member States Each country report provides essential definitional information regarding the various forms of sexual exploitation of children and types of missing children outlines the way data collection on sexual exploited and missing children by various governmental police judicial other and non governmental actors is organised and deliver available data on the phenomena concerned A final comparative report bridges the country report information into a first Union wide epidemiological state of the art thus showing that current data collection is organised in a very chaotic and poor fashion At the same time the report identifies the main weaknesses and shortcomings of applied data collection methods It also offers a set of recommendations for both Member State and EU action in striving for improved and integrated ways of collecting administering and centralising reliable comparable and comprehensive data on the various forms of missing and sexually exploited children
