Likewise, Christian right leaders championed a particular vision of masculinity in their campaigns against gay rights and nuclear disarmament. Movements like the Promise Keepers called men to take

responsibility for leading their families Christian right political campaigns and pro family organizations drew on conservative evangelical beliefs about men women children and authority These beliefs known collectively as family values became the most important religious agenda in late twentieth century American politics **Freedom of Speech** Patricia L.
