disturbing and surprising many of these stories particularly the early ones are essential to an understanding of Woolf's development as a writer. She thought some of her short fiction might be unprintable but happily she was mistaken.

**Selected Critical Writings** David Herbert Lawrence, 1998. A critic must be able to feel the impact of a work of art in all its complexity and force. To do so he must be a man of force and complexity himself. A critic must be emotionally alive in every fibre, intellectually capable and skilful in essential logic and then morally very honest. These comments by D. H. Lawrence are as close a description as any of himself as a critic. They come from his essay on fellow novelist John Galsworthy and there are many other pieces on novels and novelists in this selection. But Lawrence's range of genres extends to poetry and plays and paintings and his critical writing encompasses an enormous variety of subjects from Aeschylus and the Apocalypse to symbolism and syphilis. For his interests are philosophical, psychological, religious, moral, sociological, historical and cultural as well as literary and artistic. This selection is a treasure trove of thought adventures by one of literature's liveliest critical spirits.

**Beckett and Modernism** Olga Beloborodova, Dirk Van Hulle, Pim Verhulst, 2018-04-13. This book of collected essays approaches Beckett's work through the context of modernism while situating it in the literary tradition at large. It builds on current debates aiming to redefine modernism in connection to concepts such as late modernism or postmodernism. Instead of definitively re-categorizing Beckett under any of these labels, the essays use his diverse oeuvre encompassing poetry, criticism, prose, theatre, radio and film as a case study to investigate and reassess the concept of modernism after postmodernism in all its complexity, covering a broad range of topics spanning Beckett's entire career. In addition to more thematic essays about art, history, politics, psychology and philosophy, the collection places his work in relation to that of other modernists such as T. S. Eliot, James Joyce, Wyndham Lewis, Gertrude Stein and Virginia Woolf as well as to the literary canon in general. It represents an important contribution to both Beckett studies and modernism studies.

**Fictions of Home** Martin Mühlheim, 2018-04-23. This study aims to counter right-wing discourses of belonging. It discusses key theoretical concepts for the study of home, focusing in particular on Marxist, feminist, postcolonial and psychoanalytic contributions. The book also maintains that postmodern celebrations of nomadism and exile tend to be incapable of providing an alternative to conservative xenophobic appropriations of home. In detailed readings of one film and six novels, a view is developed according to which home as a spatio-temporal imaginary is rooted in our species being and as such constitutes the inevitable starting point for any progressive politics.

**A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man** James Joyce, 2008-06-12. Once upon a time and a very good time it was, there was a moocow coming down along the road and this moocow that was coming down along the road met a nice little boy named baby tuckoo.
