Brown v. Board of Education (1954) - ✓✓SEGREGATION decision that declared state laws segregating schools to be unconstitutional. Overturned Plessy v. Ferguson (1896), the separate but equal ruling.

14th Amendment - US Constitution - ✓✓CITIZENS All citizens have the right to equal protection of the law in all states. Declared that all persons born in the US were citizens, that all citizens were entitled to equal rights and their rights were protected by due process.

15th Amendment - US Constitution - ✓✓VOTE The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude.

Civil Rights Act (1964) - ✓✓Prohibited discrimination against racial, ethnic, national and religious minorities, and women. Ended unequal application of voter registration requirements and racial segregation in schools, at the workplace and by facilities that served the general public (known as "public accommodations").

Swann v. Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education (1971) - ✓✓BUSING Bused anti-segregation ruling. Busing was an appropriate remedy for the problem of racial imbalance in schools, even when the imbalance resulted from the selection of students based on geographic proximity to the school rather than from deliberate assignment based on race.
