Type of Setting: This lesson will be taught in a self-contained 4th/5th grade classroom. The 4th and 5th graders separate during the math lessons, so only seven students will be present for the lesson.

1. PURPOSE

This lesson will help the students gain a better understanding of place value by comparing and ordering decimals to thousandths

Essential Questions-

"How can you use place value to compare and order decimals?"

2. VOCABULARY & KEY TERMS

Decimal: The point or dot used to separate the whole number part from the fractional part of a number

Place Value: the value of where the digit is in the number, such as unit, tens, etc. Example. In the number 3.544, the place value of 5 is tenths.

3. OBJECTIVE(S)

Students will be able to identify place values.

Students will be able to order decimal numbers by comparing the place values up to the thousandths place.

Write the essential question on the board, "How can you use place value to compare and order decimals?" Call on a student to read the question and discuss that by the completion of this lesson we will be able to it. Then, ask the student "When do we compare or order
