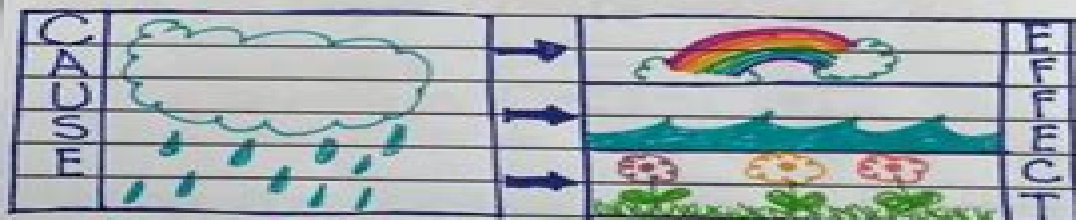
Cause and Effect

• A writer will use cause and effect to show the relationship between events or ideas.

CAUSE is why it happened
EFFECT is what happened

• A cause can have more than one effect.

• Multiple causes can have only one effect



• A writer might use cause and effect to explain how or why historical or scientific events happened
