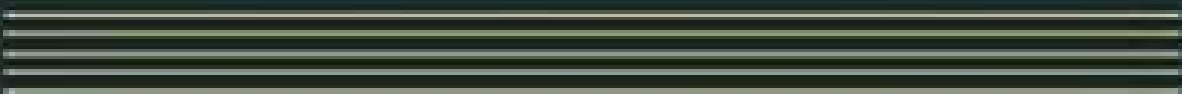


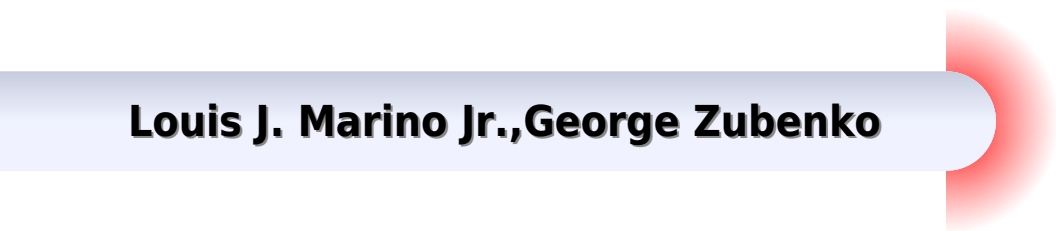

been I hope they were less significant than those of which I was aware I wrote this book mainly as part of an effort to reverse certain trends in psychiatric education In the last decade psychiatrists have increasingly been trained in an environment that emphasizes brief evaluation of patients and de emphasizes teaching about the complexity of human behavior and experience Trainees no longer study psychiatric evaluation in a systematic manner They take fewer intensive histories fill out forms instead of describing the patient's mental status and with rare exceptions are not taught how to conceptualize biological and psychosocial interactions
