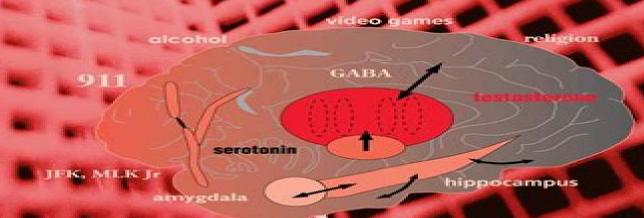

The major glutamatergic afferents to the striatum from the cerebral cortex make monosynaptic contact with spiny projection neurons The dopaminergic afferents from the substantia nigra also synapse directly on the spiny projection neurons. Thus the spiny projection neurons play a crucial role in the input output operations of the striatum by integrating glutamatergic cortical inputs with dopaminergic inputs and producing the
