Rankine, 2008-12-30 In this groundbreaking work Patrice D Rankine asserts that the classics need not be a mark of Eurocentrism as they have long been considered Instead the classical tradition can be part of a self conscious prideful approach to African American culture esthetics and identity *Ulysses in Black* demonstrates that similar to their white counterparts African American authors have been students of classical languages literature and mythologies by such writers as Homer Euripides and Seneca *On the Corner* Daniel Matlin, 2013-11-01 In July 1964 after a decade of intense media focus on civil rights protest in the Jim Crow South a riot in Harlem abruptly shifted attention to the urban crisis embroiling America's northern cities *On the Corner* revisits the volatile moment when African American intellectuals were thrust into the spotlight as indigenous interpreters of black urban life to white America and when black urban communities became the chief objects of black intellectuals perceived social obligations Daniel Matlin explores how the psychologist Kenneth B Clark the literary author and activist Amiri Baraka and the visual artist Romare Bearden each wrestled with the opportunities and dilemmas of their heightened public stature Amid an often fractious interdisciplinary debate black intellectuals furnished sharply contrasting representations of black urban life and vied to establish their authority as indigenous interpreters In time however Clark Baraka and Bearden each concluded that acting as interpreters for white America placed dangerous constraints on black intellectual practice *On the Corner* reveals how the condition of entry into the public sphere for African American intellectuals in the post civil rights era has been confinement to what Clark called the topic that is reserved for blacks **Witnessing Sadism in Texts of the American South** Claire Raymond, 2019-10-28 Looking at works by Carrie Mae Weems Toni Morrison Emily Dickinson Flannery O'Connor Dorothy Allison Carson McCullers and Zora Neale Hurston Claire Raymond uncovers a pattern of femininity constructed around representations of sadistic violence in American women's literature and photography from the late nineteenth and twentieth centuries Dickinson's poetry is read through its relationship to the Southern Agrarian critics who championed her work While the representations of violence found in Carrie Mae Weems's installation *From Here I Saw What Happened and I Cried* Morrison's *Beloved* Dickinson's poetry O'Connor's *A View of the Woods* and Allison's *Bastard Out of Carolina* McCullers' *Ballad of the Sad Café* and Hurston's *Mules and Men* are diverse in terms of artistic presentation all allude to or are set in the antebellum and Jim Crow South In addition all involve feminine characters whose subjectivity is shaped by the practice of seeing acts of violence inflicted where there can be no effective resistance While not proposing an equivalence between representing violence in visual images and written text Raymond does suggest that visual images of violence can be interpreted in context with written evocations of violent imagery Invoking sadism in its ethical sense of violence enacted on a victim for whom self defense and recourse of any kind are impossible Raymond's study is ultimately an exploration of the idea that a femininity

constructed by the positioning of feminine characters as witnesses to sadistic acts is a phenomenon distinctly of the American South that is linked to the culture's history of racism

Continental Philosophy and the Palestinian Question Zahi Zalloua, 2017-02-23 From Sartre to Levinas continental philosophers have looked to the example of the Jew as the paradigmatic object of and model for ethical inquiry Levinas for example powerfully dedicates his 1974 book *Otherwise than Being* to the victims of the Holocaust and turns attention to the state of philosophy after Auschwitz Such an ethics radically challenges prior notions of autonomy and comprehension two key ideas for traditional ethical theory and more generally the Greek tradition It seeks to respect the opacity of the other and avoid the dangers of hermeneutic violence But how does such an ethics of the other translate into real everyday life What is at stake in thinking the other as Jew Is the alterity of the Jew simply a counter to Greek universalism Is a rhetoric of exceptionalism with its unavoidable ontological residue at odds with shifting political realities Within this paradigm what then becomes of the Arab or Muslim the other of the Jew the other of the other so to speak This line of ethical thought in its desire to bear witness to past suffering and come to terms with subjectivity after Auschwitz arguably brackets from analysis present operations of power Would then a more sensitive historical approach expose the Palestinian as the other of the Israeli Here Zahi Zalloua offers a challenging intervention into how we configure the contemporary

No Duty to Retreat Richard Maxwell Brown, 1994 In 1865 Wild Bill Hickok killed Dave Tutt in a Missouri public square in the West's first notable walkdown One hundred and twenty nine years later Bernard Goetz shot four threatening young men in a New York subway car Apart from gunfire what do the two events have in common Goetz writes Richard Maxwell Brown was acquitted of wrongdoing in the spirit of a uniquely American view of self defense a view forged in frontier gunfights like Hickok's When faced with a deadly threat we have the right to stand our ground and fight We have no duty to retreat

Race Experts Elisabeth Lasch-Quinn, 2002-12-17 Controversial and strikingly original *Race Experts* looks at how we capsized racial progress in the quest for self esteem Now available in paperback it uncovers the hidden trajectory and terms of our thinking about race relations since the 1960s Since segregation's dismantling intense anxiety has surrounded interracial encounters and a movement has arisen to engineer social relations through the specification of elaborate codes of conduct Diversity Training in business multicultural education in schools and cross cultural psychotherapy have created a world of prescriptions Elisabeth Lasch Quinn carefully examines the teachings of these self appointed experts and offers a bold and searching analysis of the origins of their ideas in the human potential movement and the radical milieu of the 1960s Casting race primarily as an issue of etiquette or therapy rather than of justice or equality has had dire consequences for American life diverting attention from the deeper problems of poverty violence and continued inequality and discrimination In this sobering analysis *Race Experts* illuminates how far away we are from the issues that deserve our attention

The Evidence of Things Not Said Lawrie Balfour, 2018-08-06 The Evidence of Things Not Said employs the rich essays of James Baldwin to interrogate the politics of race in American democracy Lawrie Balfour advances the political discussion of Baldwin s work and regards him as a powerful political thinker whose work deserves full consideration Baldwin s essays challenge appeals to race blindness and formal but empty guarantees of equality and freedom They undermine white presumptions of racial innocence and simultaneously refute theories of persecution that define African Americans solely as innocent victims Unsettling fixed categories Baldwin s essays construct a theory of race consciousness that captures the effects of racial identity in everyday experience Balfour persuasively reads Baldwin s work alongside that of W E B Du Bois to accentuate how double consciousness works differently on either side of the color line She contends that the allusiveness and incompleteness of Baldwin s essays sustains the tension between general claims about American racial history and the singularity of individual experiences The Evidence of Things Not Said establishes Baldwin s contributions to democratic theory and situates him as an indispensable voice in contemporary debates about racial injustice

E Pluribus Barnum Bluford Adams, 1997 The first book to consider the career of P T Barnum from a cultural studies perspective Phineas Taylor Barnum lived from 1810 until 1891 and in the eighty one years of his life he created show business as we know it In E Pluribus Barnum Bluford Adams investigates the influence Barnum had on American popular culture of the nineteenth century and expands our understanding of the ways he continues to influence us today Beginning with a discussion of Barnum s early shows Adams demonstrates the dynamic interplay between Barnum s increasingly respectable aspirations for his entertainments and his active cultivation of middle class sensibilities in his audiences In his discussion of the 1850 51 concert tour of the Swedish

Nightingale Jenny Lind Adams explores the role played by women's rights and class issues in Barnum's management of these concerts. Barnum's American Museum and the moral dramas presented in its theater are examined as well as the later circuses. Adams relates the rise of Barnum to the emergence of a new U.S. society one riven by conflicts over slavery, feminism, immigration, and capitalism, and considers his career as a crucial moment in the on-going struggle over the politics of U.S. commercial entertainments.

Race, Color, Identity Efraim Sicher, 2013-05-01 Advances in genetics are renewing controversies over inherited characteristics and the discourse around science and technological innovations has taken on racial overtones such as attributing inherited physiological traits to certain ethnic groups or using DNA testing to determine biological links with ethnic ancestry. This book contributes to the discussion by opening up previously locked concepts of the relation between the terms color, race, and Jews, and by engaging with globalism, multiculturalism, hybridity, and diaspora. The contributors, leading scholars in anthropology, sociology, history, literature, and cultural studies, discuss how it is not merely a question of whether Jews are acknowledged to be interracial, but how to address academic and social discourses that continue to place Jews and others in a race/color category.

Am I Black Enough for You? Todd Boyd, 1997-03-22 The most creative moments of African American culture have always emanated from a lower class or ghetto perspective. In contemporary society, this ghetto aesthetic has informed a large segment of the popular marketplace from the incendiary nature of gangsta rap through the choreographed violence of films like *Menace II Society* to recurrent debates around the use of the word nigger and even the assertion of this perspective in professional basketball. In each case, most of the discussion around these cultural circumstances tends to be dismissive if not completely uninformed. In analyzing the ranges of images from the O.J. Simpson trial to Snoop Doggy Dogg, *Am I Black Enough for You?* looks at the way in which the nuances of ghetto life get translated into the politics of popular culture and especially the way these politics have become such a profitable venture for both the entertainment industry and the actual producers of these topical narratives. The book follows the widening generation gap represented by Bill Cosby's pristine race man image in the mid-80s, culminating in the proliferation of the hard-core sentiments associated with the nigger in the 1990s. The book argues for a historical understanding of these contemporary examples which is rooted in the social policies of the Reagan-Bush era, the declining industrial base of urban communities, and the increasing significance of the drug trade and gang culture. In addition, the book follows the evolution of gangster culture in twentieth-century American popular culture and the shift from ethnicity to race that slowly begins to emerge over this time period. Contrary to mainstream conservative sentiment, *Am I Black Enough for You?* suggests that the criticism of gangsta culture is a misguided attempt which reaffirms traditional views about Black culture. This criticism is articulated across race so that in many cases African Americans articulate the same sentiments as their white conservative counterparts. *Am I Black Enough for You?* offers astute analysis of the liberating possibilities of representation that lie at the core of contemporary black popular culture.

off the line I m Lucky Luciano bout to sing soprano Like the Brooklyn pizzeria and candy store in Spike Lee s Do the Right Thing and Jungle Fever or the basketball sidelines where Italian American coaches Rick Pitino and John Calipari mix it up with their African American players black Italian connections are a thing to behold and to investigate In Flavor and Soul John Gennari spotlights this affinity calling it the edge now smooth sometimes serrated between Italian American and African American culture He argues that the edge is a space of mutual emulation and suspicion a joyous cultural meeting sometimes darkened by violent collision Through studies of music and sound film and media sports and foodways Gennari shows how an Afro Italian sensibility has nourished and vitalized American culture writ large even as Italian Americans and African Americans have fought each other for urban space recognition of overlapping histories of suffering and exclusion and political and personal rispetto Thus Flavor and Soul is a cultural contact zone a piazza where people express deep feelings of joy and pleasure wariness and distrust amity and enmity And it is only at such cultural edges Gennari argues that America can come to truly understand its racial and ethnic dynamics

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
