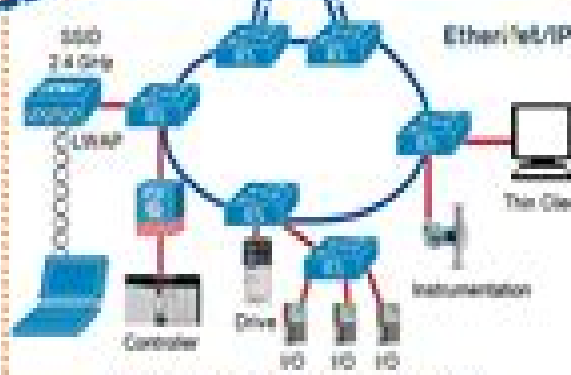

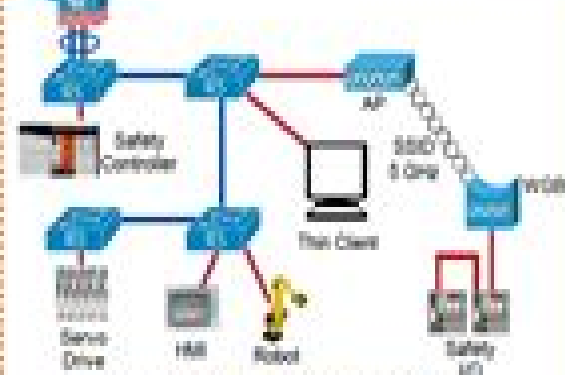

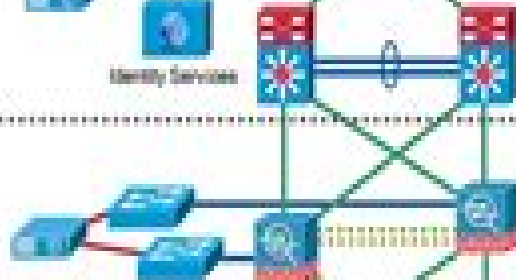


Cell/Area Zone - Levels 0-2

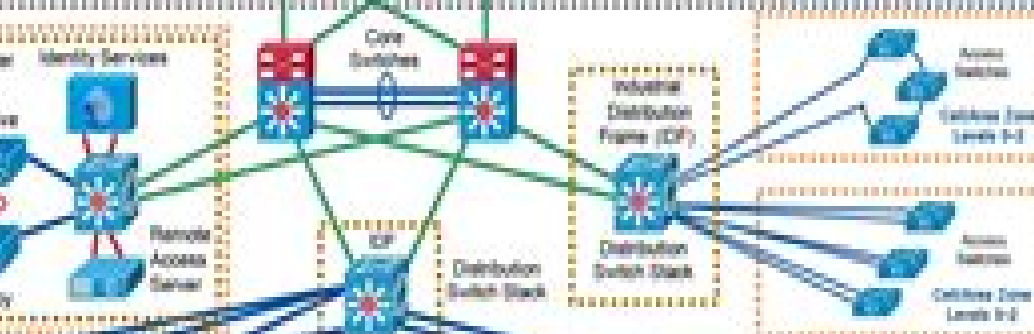
